Why PUC-Campinas?

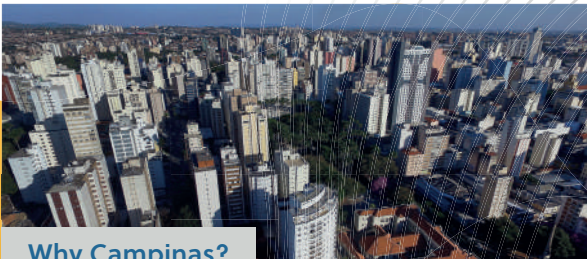
Pontifícia Universidade Católica de Campinas (Pontifical Catholic University of Campinas) is a private institution, located in an economic, social and technological fast developing region, with a wide industrial park. PUC-Campinas has more than 60 undergraduate courses and 13 graduate programs. Our professors are highly qualified. It has a state-of-the-art infrastructure and a built area of 196,000 m², spread over its two *campi*.

Since its foundation, in 1941, PUC-Campinas has graduated over 180,000 students who, currently, compose Brazil's intellectual and professional elite. The university has also received important awards for its educational quality, among them the "Melhor Universidade Privada do Brasil na Área da Saúde" (Brazil's Best Private University in the Health Field) over four years in a row.

PUC-Campinas is one of the few Brazilian universities that have a teaching hospital – Hospital e Maternidade Celso Pierro (HMCP) -, which is located at Campus II and it's listed among the 10 Colleges of its School of Life Sciences, which aims to provide the students practical education. It also has the feature of high-level performance, recognized as an important benchmark in several health areas.

During its more than 40 years of service, the HMCP is a major accomplishment of the university. It serves the population, the students and fulfils its mission to promote health and knowledge, upholding the Christian values and character of the Hospital.

Being a structured, recognized and well known university, it brings together the best human and material resources to provide a complete and capital higher education, in line with current demands and focused on the challenges of the future.



Why Campinas?

The Metropolitan Region of Campinas (RMC) has almost 3 million inhabitants and it's one of the most dynamic Brazilian economies. This region also has an infrastructure that supports the development for the whole metropolitan area, including the second largest air cargo terminal in the country (Viracopos International Airport - VCP).



Infrastructure and Resources

With an academic community of almost 20,000 people, including undergraduate and graduate students, professors and researchers, PUC-Campinas is the largest private university in the state of São Paulo midland. To support such an extensive academic population, it relies on material and human resources such as:

Laboratories in all fields of knowledge;
System of integrated libraries;
Ateliers, workshops, animal research areas, and all necessary resources for practical activities for the different courses and research programs;
The university hospital, with over 300 beds, around 240,000 appointments per year, provides internship programs that work as practical learning for 11 courses in the health area;
